





Amanda Wigglesworth graduated from Manchester Metropolitan




Electric Blue

Art is the tool of Allan's professional practice and through education and psychotherapy has underpinned his working practice in community theatre, mental health and complex needs .


Based in St. Ives and London, he is a member of the Federation of British Artists, the Hesketh Hubbard Art Society and the St. Ives Art Club.



His largest painting to date, is a large canvas twenty four feet height by eight feet width, extending from the ground floor entrance hall to the first floor landing for a large interior art project in an executive apartment of a McAlpine development luxury show home in Chelsea, London.

Other artworks have featured in national tournaments in the USA., event logos as far away as Columbia, CD album covers and television series.

Allan also provides workshops and is a respected art tutor and lecturer.






Calm Visitations
